Department of Chemistry Regulations of Postgraduate Student Support Funds Issuance Evaluation

Issued by the 6th Departmental General Meeting on April 14, 1999, School Year of 87.

Issued by the 7th Departmental General Meeting on May 18, 2004, School Year of 92.

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I. Receivers of support funds:

The support funds are distributed to teaching assistants. In general, the support funds are distributed to new students of each group in each year. In cases of numbers of new students being insufficient for applications, applications will be first open to the existing students of the same groups.

II. Amounts of support funds:

The amounts of support funds are evenly distributed in accordance with annual funds received by the department.

III. Number of places:

A total of 34 places including 6 teaching assistants of instrumental analysis experiments, 6 teaching assistants of physical chemistry experiments, 1 teaching assistant of analysis experiments, 8 teaching assistants of organic experiments, and 13 teaching assistants of general chemistry experiments. Each group is assigned with 8.5 teaching assistants and may issue its own election criteria. Depending on numbers of places distributed in each group and numbers of teaching assistants assigned for each experiment, numbers of supporting assistants for general chemistry experiments from physical chemistry group, analysis group, and organic group are 2.5, 1.5, and 0.5 respectively.

IV. Distribution periods:

A total of 11 months starting from the registration month (September) to June in the next year.

V. Distributions of tasks:

Experiment classes, which the teaching assistants of each group are responsible for, are coordinated and assigned by the academic committee. Contents of tasks are assigned by the faculty members in charge for the experiments.

VI. This set of regulations shall be amended by the academic committee in accordance with practical requirements and implemented following approvals of college general meetings.
