Department of Chemistry Regulations of Professor Emeritus Appointments

Issued by the 6th Department General Meeting on June 6, 2008, School Year of 96.

- I. National Sun Yat-sen University (NSYSU) wishes to respect professors who have had significant contributions to teaching, research, or administrations. This set of regulations is based on organizational regulations of the university and is initiated to honor professors with the title “professor emeritus” after they retire.
- II. A professor emeritus shall meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - A. A full-time professor who has worked 15 years or more in NSYSU and had significant performances in teaching and research, or who has worked part-time on administrative positions and had significant contributions to organizations, establishments, and developments of department, college, and university affairs.
 - B. A full-time professor who has worked seven years or more in the Department of Chemistry, has had significant academic contributions, and is internationally renowned.

For items described in previous paragraph, years of full-time teaching shall exclude periods of unpaid leaves, except for those who returned to fulfill teaching obligations. Periods before and after unpaid leaves may be collectively accounted for calculating years of teaching.

- III. Nominations and appointments of professor emeriti are processed as follows:
 - A. A nomination shall be made by one or more full-time professor(s), associate professor(s), or assistant professor(s) of the Department of Chemistry and submitted to the Department General Meeting for discussion and review.
 - B. Votes by ballot shall be held. Approval will be determined when half (or more) of the Department General Meeting attendants agreeing to accept the nomination.
 - C. Cases of candidates nominated and appointed shall be submitted to the College General Meeting of the College of Science and the University Faculty Evaluation Meeting for reviews.
- IV. This set of regulations shall be implemented following approval of the Department General Meeting. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
